FLORIDA FILM INSTITUTE LAUNCHES INTENSIVE SCRIPT WRITING WORKSHOP

MIAMI, FL – Registration is now open for *Crafting Scenes... Creating Actions* the Florida Film Institute's intensive script writing workshop. Conducted by Alyn Darnay, an award-winning writer and director, the workshop will meet once a week from 6:30 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. on Mondays, March 7, 14, and 21 at the Sheraton Biscayne Bay located on 495 Brickell Avenue.

Although it is recommended for the serious scriptwriter, the workshop will be beneficial for writers, producers, directors, novelists, playwrights, and actors as well. This will not just be a series of lectures. Every workshop is interactive and everyone has the chance to participate. Participants are required to present their work and then write alternatives to their scenes based on the workshop concepts. Because scriptwriting cannot be fully grasped without active performance, professional actors will also be invited in to perform scenes from participants' scripts.
